

# Anticipating Exam Content



1. **Concentrate on areas that were EMPHASIZED in notes or by the instructor!**
2. **Try to PREDICT what the professor will ask.**
3. **ASK the instructor what to expect.**
4. **Know in advance what TYPE of exam will be given—multiple choice, essay, true/false or a combination.**
5. **Obtain OLD EXAMS**
6. **Generate a LIST of possible exam questions**
7. **REVIEW previous exams to see what the professor asked in the past.**
8. **CONFER with other students.**
9. **Pay attention to CLUES from the professor—saying something more than once, writing material on the board, pausing the review notes, etc.**
10. **Attend REVIEW SESSIONS—sometimes tips are given!**
